## Course Description

Homework is graded on effort and completion only:
$100 \%$ = complete, work shown and organized
$50 \%$ = work turned in late
0\% = homework not turned in, incomplete, missing work or steps
*Student may receive 80\% if completed homework reflects a problem in comprehension
*It is strongly encouraged that students turn in any "NTI" work the following day in order to receive a $50 \%$

## Academic Procedures

*Make up Work: We will follow the Make Up work policy stated in the STS Middle School handbook. It is a student's responsibility to check Veracross when absent to find out the missed assignment and to turn in the make-up work within the allowed time.
*Extra Credit: I do not assign extra credit projects. Each test has a bonus question that serves as extra credit.
*Assessments: Tests and quizzes are given periodically to assess student understanding at a specific point and time. Re-takes are granted to students who earn a D or F on an assessment. The retake grade will replace the original grade, however the highest grade possible on a re-take shall be a $77 \%$.
*Extra Help is held on Thursday afternoons. Pick up is promptly at $3: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ in carpool. Students should come prepared to Extra Help with questions with which they are having trouble. I cannot guarantee one-on-one time during extra help sessions.
